Respected Sir,

Sub: Special drive to fill up the vacant posts of Postmen, Mail Guard and MTS in Delhi circle from surplus qualified willing candidates of LDCE 2022 & 2023 of all circles - regd.

This is regarding notification issued by Delhi Circle for filling up of vacant posts in Postman/Mail Guard and MTS Cadre to the tune of approximately 3183 posts. In this regard I would like to thank Directorate for considering this union proposal for offering unfilled PM/MG & MTS Posts in Delhi Circle from candidates (of other circles Pan India) qualified in LCE for the Vacancy Years 2022 & 2023.

However this Federation would like to bring the following issues to your kind notice for perusal and immediate intervention and favourable orders.

01. As on date many circles have not released Postman/Mail Guard and MTS Results for the year 2023.
02. Application has to be submitted duly verified & signed by Divisional Head and with Recommendations of & duly signed by of Head of the Circle.
03. Applicants have to submit separate application for Both Postman/ Mail Guard & MTS Posts.
04. Nowhere in the application column eligibility of the official for the vacancy years i.e., whether the GDS is eligible for Both 2022 & 2023 or 2023 only was no where available.
05. Column requesting Community of the candidate is now where available in the application proforma.
06. Column requesting Marks secured by the GDS in the exams conducted for 2022 & 2023 is nowhere available in the proforma.
07. Column requesting Date of Birth of the GDS is nowhere available in the proforma. Which is crucial in determining seniority in case of tie up of marks?

It is opined that Delhi Circle is assuming that circles will forward the applications with all the requisite data, but no such clear requisition was not made by the Delhi circle to the Circles not any proforma was suggested for data while forwarding applications.

In view of the above issues, GDS of many circles are not having a clear idea as to how selection will be made and have not applied hoping for a clear communication / clarification.

In this scenario, given the huge number of vacancies, the entire purpose will be defeated and result in huge dissent in GDS Cadre. Further it is a known fact, that manual processing of applications of this quantum is a highly tedious task and prone to errors, further leading to huge delay.


It is requested to consider the following suggestions in this regard.

- a) Extend the last date of notification to 31.01.23, so that all the circles could complete declaration of results for the year 2023 by 31.12.23.
- b) Revise the application format duly incorporating necessary changes.
- c) CEPT may directed to prepare a software in line with that of PS Group B / IPO. As the marks are available in soft copy / digital format at Circles, details of qualified whiz marks, community, whether eligible for either years or single year in respect of surplus qualified candidates can be incorporated in the software.
- d) Sub Divisional Heads to collect willingness format / revised application form from willing qualified GDS and feed the data in software and transfer the same to Divisional office.
- e) Divisional office will check up the data in software with Physical Willingness format / revised application form and accord their recommendations in the software itself.
- f) The data shall flow directly to Delhi Circle, where data of all circles are processed by software itself and release the results.

I implore the Kind authority to be pleased to consider the suggestions and cause to issue necessary orders so as to benefit the deserving GDS and also for better transparency and timely process.
