
Sub : Hunger fast in front of All Postal Circle offices demanding 1) Inclusion of GDS issues in the terms of reference of seventh CPC and 2) Grant of civil servant status to GDS

It is understood that the report of the 7th CPC is on the last stage of completion and it will be submitted to the central government very soon. There were several requests from the unions in Postal service to include the problems of GDS employees to the purview of 7th CPC. Though an indefinite strike was planned raising this demand, the case was discussed on 05.05.2015 by the union leaders with the Honorable Minister Shri Ravi Sankar Prasadji, who had found the demand as genuine promised to recommend the issue to the ministry for finance. Due to misfortune, it was rejected by the Finance Ministry again. Though 5 months has elapsed, we sadly note that the Department has not taken any steps to settle the GDS issues.

All the GDS employees are agitated on the attitude of the Department as well as the Government. To project the issues before the Government and the public the GDS employees are going to conduct a hunger fast on the banner of NUGDS before the Chief Post Masters General Offices of All Circles on 28.10.2015 from 10 AM to 5PM.

We take this opportunity to intimate the Department that if effective steps are not taken immediately on the issues of GDS employees, we will be constrained to move to the next course of agitation. I hope your good office will see the issues seriously and take all steps without delay

Sub : Leaving of GDS issues to the 7th CPC

It is understood that the 7th CPC will submit its report to the Government soon. The postal unions have been requesting the Government/ Department to leave the issues of GDS to the 7th CPC in the last 18 months. The FNPO and NFPE Federations along with the GDS unions had planned an indefinite strike from 06.05.2015 on the issue. On the basis of the discussions held with the Secretaries Generals of the federations and senior officers of DOP in your presence on 05.05.2015, the strike was deferred on the basis of your promise to recommend the case to Ministry of Finance. The request was rejected by the Ministry of Finance again. Though 5 months has been since elapsed, no action of any kind has been taken by the Department on the issues of GDS coming about 3 lakhs in number. NUGDS is strongly agitated and we express our strong protest against the attitude of the DOP and the Government.

As the first step of the agitation, a hunger fast on 28.10.2015 will be conducted in front of all Circle offices.

We humbly request you to see the case seriously and to take all steps to put an end for the sacrifice of the poor and ill paid GDS staff at the earliest
