My Federation conveys sincere thanks for the early clarification issued on the above subject keeping in view of difficulties of the terminated GDS officials.

In this connection it is to emphasize that in some circles like Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Bihar etc., also the action related to restoration of services of the GDS officials who are terminated under Rule 8 of GDS conduct Rules are still pending. Many of such poor GDS are anxiously waiting for the orders of restoration. Hence, kindly issue same instructions to all other circle to dispose pending petitions at an early date.

Many of the union leaders and GDS officials also got Charge sheets under Rule 10B and facing disciplinary proceedings because of strike. Such vindictive action may kindly be withdrawn immediately for restoration of industrial harmony in our department.

My Federation also requested to take suitable action on the demands placed by the staff unions during the strike period.

An early action will be highly appreciated.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Clarification regarding admissibility of travel by Tejas trains while availing of LTC - reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No. 31011/8/2017-Estt. A.IV dated 19.09.2017 on the subject noted above, which *inter-alia* provides that the travel entitlements of Government servants for the purpose of LTC shall be the same as that of TA entitlements, as notified vide Department of Expenditure (DoE), MoF's OM No. 19030/1/2017-E.IV dated 13.07.2017, except the air travel entitlement for Level 6 to Level 8 of the Pay Matrix, which is allowed in respect of TA only and not for LTC.

2. This Department has been receiving a number of references including RTI applications regarding admissibility of Tejas trains on LTC.

3. The matter has been examined in consultation with Department of Expenditure (DoE) wherein the DoE has informed that Tejas Rajdhani Express Trains are covered under DoE's OM No. 19030/1/2017-E.IV dated 13.07.2017. Accordingly, it is clarified that in addition to trains mentioned in the DOPT's OM No. 31011/8/2017-Estt.A-IV dated 19.09.2017 only **Tejas Rajdhani Express Trains** are covered. Further, it is also clarified that **the reimbursement of ticket fare of Tejas Express trains is not allowed under LTC.**

4. The claim of reimbursement in respect of LTC journey is to be settled as per the above instructions, however the cases which have already been settled, need not be reopened.

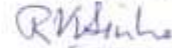

The following issues were brought to the notice about the problems with SAP Server,

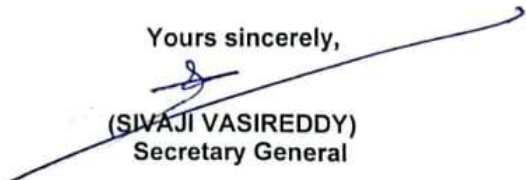
SAP Problems: After setting up of MMUs at all levels it was expected by the officials at field level that the problem that have been faced in SAP and DPMS will be resolved. But the things are going in contra. Functioning of SAP at Crucial times on Mondays and on the next day of Holiday is very slow and the lag in functioning of DPMS has been continuing. In spite of Server issues, the MMUs are just increasing pressure on Operative Staff and Delivery Staff for improvement in MMU Parameters. Some MMUs/DHs are advising/ordering thru whatsapp groups to the field units to go back to the manual Delivery Slip Procedure which will be cumbersome and also to be in office beyond working hours till restoration of SAP even without mentioning expected time of restoration.

Many GL Codes and functions like daily account, GL Codes of PLI, RPLI, GL Codes of Bank Reconciliation etc are being in locked status during the working hours, showing the message that the 'GL Code is Blocked/Locked', due to this many important works of preventive vigilance works like tallying of schedules, PLI/RPLI reconciliation have been taking much time causing unproductive work hours.

The issues may please be pursued with concerned vendors and cause effective working and implementation of software provided so as to avoid unproductive work hours.

Funds are not available at CO/RO to distribute to Divisions for primary expenditure. Due to this essential/mandatory expenditure has been met by advances in some instances in Post Offices. The Land lords are causing inconvenience to the officials demanding for Rent dues. Daily wage workers like sweeper, scavenger etc are suffering a lot.

The issue may please be pursued and immediate necessary action may please be taken for allotment of RE Funds and other required Funds to the CO/RO/Divisions

50% DA Milestone, from January 2024: How it transforms your Allowances 50%DA-milestone-from-January-2024 after almost 09 years-how-it-transforms-your-allowances

With the available Consumer Price Index for Industrial Workers (CPI-IW) indices as published by the Labour Bureau, it is seen that the Dearness Allowance for the central government employees will be at least 50%. As a central government employee, you're well aware of the significance of Dearness Allowance (DA) in your compensation structure. It's a dynamic element that adjusts to the ever-evolving cost of living. The 7th Central Pay Commission had made provisions for hiking the allowances when the DA crosses 50%. However, what happens when DA hits the critical 50% milestone? How does this milestone impact your allowances and financial benefits as a central government employee?

It is expected that the Rate of DA will hit 50% Level from January 2024. When DA reaches 50%, certain allowances and salary components will be increased, as recommended by the 7th Pay Commission. These allowances include:

House Rent Allowance
Children Education Allowance
Special Allowance for Child Care Subsidy
TA on Transfer (Transportation of Personal Effects) Ceiling
Gratuity Dress Allowance
Mileage Allowance for Own Transport Allowance
Daily House Rent Allowance (HRA)

The rates of HRA have been revised to 27%, 18%, and 9% of Basic Pay in X, Y, and Z cities when DA crosses 25%. The allowances have been revised according to the 7th CPC recommendation. No separate order is needed to revise this allowance, as the government has accepted the recommendation.

The percentage of HRA shall be increased as per the following table when DA reaches 50%:

Reimbursement	of Travelling Charges:				
Similar to reimbursement of staying accommodation charges, for levels 8 and below, the claim (up to the ceiling) may be paid without the production of vouchers against self-certified claims only. The self-certified claim should indicate the period of travel, vehicle number, etc. The ceiling for levels 11 and below will further rise by 25 per cent whenever DA increases by 50 per cent. For journeys on foot, an allowance of Rs. 12/- per kilometre travelled on foot shall be payable additionally. This rate will further increase by 25 per cent whenever DA increases by 50 per cent.					
Reimbursement	of Food Charges:				
There will be no separate reimbursement of food bills. Instead, the lump sum amount payable will be as per Table E(i) above and, depending on the length of absence from headquarters, would be regulated. Since the concept of reimbursement has been done away with, no vouchers will be required. This methodology is in line with that followed by Indian Railways at present (with suitable enhancement of rates). i.e. Lump sum amount payable. The lump sum amount will increase by 25 per cent whenever DA increases by 50 per cent.

Honourable Sir,

It is to bring the following issue with due respect to the kind notice of the Honourable Minister, related to the lakhs of Grameen Dak Sevaks working majorly in Rural Areas in Department of Posts.

The GDS are the persons working in Department of Posts majorly in Rural Areas and contributing much for Financial Inclusion with a good reach to the Public across the country. Kamalesh Chandra Committee is the committee deployed for revision of wages and allowances of these GDS. Some of the recommendations were implemented during the year 2018. As per the engagement Rules these GDS are not regular employees of Department of Posts. The Staff Unions have been fighting since decades for regular status to the GDS. As part the trade unions of Departments of Post have been in deliberations with Department for regular status and implementations of positive recommendations of Kamalesh Chandra Committee. Consequent on different types of programs and negotiations, unfortunately the fight had led to Strike and lakhs of GDS officials went on strike from 12-12-2023. The Strike had succeeded on first 2 days.

Aggrieved with this the higher authorities served notices of Termination to the GDS officials with less than 3 years of service. Subsequently keeping in view of future of lakhs of employees and hindrance to the public service in Rural Areas the strike was withdrawn by the Trade Unions and the officials joined to duty on 14-12-2023. But the termination notices issued were not withdrawn. Thousands of the GDS officials were terminated from services in some states and the sword is on the necks of GDS officials of other states. Many of the Trade Union leaders of GDS wing and other wings were given show cause notices/charge sheets.

It has been requested with the Secretary Posts, Department of Posts to withdraw the notices and to restore the normal situation before the strike. GDS are the poor, meritorious youth employed thru merit in SSC in department. Though they are not regular employees they have been striving hard for Financial Inclusion in Rural Areas of the Country. The stunning incidents happened had brought the lives of GDS Officials and family members to hell and the officials are spending sleepless nights with the about their future and career.

At this juncture it is to request the generous, Honourable Minister sir to refer the case with the Ministry of Communications and Secretary Posts with a kind heart to restore the situations back by withdrawing the notices given to the GDS Officials and others in this connection.
